## Vaccines

\*FeLV (Feline Leukemia Virus) - this vaccine is considered a core vaccine for kittens to provide baseline immunity. At 1 year of age, this vaccine is discontinued if the cats are indoor only. Outdoor cats are at risk of exposure and annual vaccination is continued.

*Spay or Neuter is usually performed between 4-6 months of age*
